

# Flooring Maintenance

Trident Industry's MTC flooring will provide years of low maintenance. Our durable protective finish, and moisture resistance will allow for easy care - keeping your floor looking new for years to come.

#### IN ORDER TO KEEP YOUR MTC Flooring CLEAN AND BEUTUFUL:

- For everyday maintenance, use damp mop - avoid flooding the floor.
- Vacuum or Sweep floor with soft bristle broom to remove dirt.
- Use "No-Rinse" non-abrasive floor cleaner.
- Do not use soap base detergents, or abrasive cleaner.
- Use large surface, non-staining floor protector for heavy furniture.
- Use interior and exterior doormats at all entrances to collect dirt and moisture and prevent it from being tracked onto the floor.
- Avoid latex or rubber mats that may stain to the floor.
- Avoid after-market coating that cause structural damage to the floor, such as cupping and staining - such will void product warranty.

#### IN CASES WITH STAINS AND SPILLS:

- For Stains and Spills such as (Acid, Blood, Alkalis, Ketchup, Mustard, Cleaners, Dye, Grass, Iodine, Mercurochrome, Rust, Urine, and Excrement):
  - Use the following remedy: (full-strength vinyl cleaner, isopropyl alcohol, 10 to 1 diluted liquid bleach, or lemon juice).
- For Paint and Solvent Spills such as (Nail Polish, Wood Varnish, Latex Paint/Lacquer, and Dry-Cleaning Solution):

- Try to gently peel it from floor without using sharp objects that may scratch the floor.
- Rub lightly using mineral spirits or vinyl cleaner.
- In case of Nail Polish Spill, use nail polish remover.
- In Cases with hard to wipe substances such as (Chewing Gum, Candle Wax, Tar, and Adhesive):
  - Carefully remove with fingernail or dull edge.
  - Rubbing it with isopropyl alcohol, mineral spirits or vinyl cleaner may help with the process.
- For Scuffs and Smudges:
  - Carefully remove with fingernail or dull edge.
  - Rubbing it with isopropyl alcohol, mineral spirits or vinyl cleaner may help with the process.

\*Always rinse the affected area with clean water after treatment.
